

## Rate Fee Schedule

### General:

The rate fee schedule and cost have been established by the Board to aid in uniform and day-to-day operations of the District. The rate fee schedule is subject to change from time to time without notice to existing or potential consumers. All fees are considered a donation to the District and shall not be refundable under any circumstance.

#### A. Water Rates.

0 to 1,000 gallons usage \$21.00 minimum  
 Rate for usage above 1,000 gallons \$5.45 / 1,000 gallons  
 \*\*\*Plus sales tax (commercial customers only) and water protection fee  
 \*\*\*Customers are billed in 100 gallons increments.

#### Multiple Occupancy Minimum Rate

#### B. Late Penalty.

Bills not paid by the 20<sup>th</sup> of each month 10% of total bill due

#### C. Final Reading.

Meter readings done in between billing cycles due to moving \$ 5.00

#### D. Return Check Fee.

Check returned for any reason \$30.00  
 Note - accounts with return check are subject to all penalty's and collection fees.

#### E. Collection Fee.

Notification of delinquent account each month \$ 5.00

**F. Reconnection Fee.**

After service has been turned off - must be paid prior to water being turned on in addition to past and current balances. \$50.00

**G. Reinstatement Fee.**

After the water right has been revoked by the board of directors, this fee must be paid before meter is reinstalled. \$1,000

**H. Meter / Lid / Ring and other Replacement Parts and/or labor work.**

Due to damage or reconstruction from consumer priced at prevailing rate from supplier plus labor costs.

**I. Benefit Unit Transfer.**

Each benefit unit transfer -from owner to owner (non-refundable) \$25.00

**J. Rental Change.**

Each rental change – administrative fee (non-refundable) \$25.00

**K. Benefit Units.** Cost of each unit and larger or commercial units:

**L. Road Bore Fees.**

Road crossing fee under normal conditions \$500.00  
\*\*Note - Larger bores or bores with rock or longer than normal bores require additional fees

**M. Main Extension Petition.**

The petition fee for main extension’s required to service new developments is \$1000.00. This is a non-refundable administrative fee.

In addition, a \$5000.00 prepayment for engineering fees is required. This amount will then be applied towards the water main extension.

**N. Hydrant Meter rental**

\$800.00 deposit + \$5.00 daily  
Plus water used.  
Deposit is refunded upon payment of bill
