# Rate Fee Schedule

### General:

The rate fee schedule and costs have been established by the Board of Directors to aid in the uniform and day-to-day operations of the Water District. The rate fee schedule is subject to change without notice to existing or potential consumers. All fees are considered a donation to the District and shall not be refundable under any circumstance.

0 to 1,000 gallons usage

### B. Late Penalty.

Bills not paid by the 20<sup>th</sup> of each month

### C. Final Reading.

Meter readings performed in between billing cycles

#### F. Reconnection Fee.

After service has been turned off - must be paid prior to water being turned on in addition to past and current balances.

After the water right has been revoked by the board of directors, this fee and all back charges must be paid before meter is reinstalled.
