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## Rate Fee Schedule

### General:

The rate fee schedule and costs have been established by the Board of Directors to aid in the uniform and day-to-day operations of the Water District. The rate fee schedule is subject to change without notice to existing or potential consumers. All fees are considered a donation to the district and shall not be refundable under any circumstance.

#### A. Water Rates.

0 to 1,000 gallons usage \$26.00 minimum  
 Rate for usage above 1,000 gallons \$5.75 / 1,000 gallons  
 \*\*\*Plus, sales tax (commercial customers only) and water protection fee  
 \*\*\*Customers are billed in 100 gallons increments.

#### B. Late Penalty.

Bills not paid by the 20<sup>th</sup> of each month 10% of total bill due

#### C. Final Reading.

Meter readings performed in between billing cycles \$ 5.00

#### D. Return Check Fee.

Check returned for any reason \$30.00  
 Note - accounts with a returned check are subject to all penalties and collection fees.

#### E. Collection Fee.

Notification of delinquent account each month \$ 5.00

**F. Reconnection Fee.**

After service has been turned off - must be paid prior to water being turned on in addition to past and current balances. \$50.00

**G. Reinstatement Fee.**

After the water right has been revoked by the board of directors, \$1,000  
This fee and all back charges must be paid before the meter is reinstalled.

**H. Water District Labor Fee**

\$50/hr + parts

**I. Benefit Unit Transfer.**

Each benefit unit transfer -from owner to owner (non-refundable) \$25.00

**J. Rental Change.**

Each rental change – administrative fee (non-refundable) \$25.00
